Clark County Fluency Benchmarks and Progress Monitoring

Grade Level Benchmarks

During the beginning of Unit 1, all 3^{rd} and 4^{th} grade students should be assessed using the beginning of the year fluency assessment. There is an optional 2^{nd} grade fluency assessment.

Directions for administration and scoring of the fluency assessments are provided in each document.

The mid-year (winter) fluency assessment should be given to all 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} , and 4^{th} grade students during the end of Unit 3. There is an optional 1^{st} grade fluency assessment available.

Then end of the year (spring) fluency assessment should be given to all 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grade students during the end of Unit 6. There is an optional 1st grade fluency assessment available.

*This data should be entered on the yellow Literacy Profile Card at the end of the school year.

Progress Monitoring

Beginning of the year to mid-year fluency progress monitoring should occur for 3^{rd} and 4^{th} grade students who score:

-below the beginning of year fluency benchmark,

or

-below the winter fluency benchmark.

Mid-year to end of the year fluency progress monitoring should occur for 2nd -4th grade students who score:

-below the mid-year (winter) fluency benchmark,

or

-below the end of the year (spring) fluency benchmark.

*Progress monitoring of fluency for RtI students may be completed in coordination with the interventionists based on each student's RtI objectives/goals.
